Present petition under Section 482 BNSS, 2023, for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.06 dated 14.01.2025, under Sections 109, 115, 351, 191(1), 190 of BNS, (Section 331(6) of BNS, 2023 and Section 25 and 27 of Arms Act, 1959 deleted vide report dated 14.05.2025), registered at Police Station Amloh, District Fatehgarh Sahib, Punjab.
