[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/3 dated 04.12.2018 in CWP No.3915 of 2018.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/3 dated 04.12.2018 reveals that while taking note of the grievance of the petitioners that they were being asked to pay tariff in respect of off-loading of gypsum from the Hydraulic Tippers for which no labour was required and about 80 Tippers crossed the border every day with cargo of gypsum which were automatically operated and gypsum was off-loaded, yet Central Warehousing Corporation had taken a decision to charge labour tariff on the same, the writ petition was disposed of by recording the statement on behalf of the Land Ports Authority of India (LPAI) (respondent No.2 therein) that the matter would be looked into by respondent No.2 therein and a fresh decision would be taken within two

months.

[3] Mr. Somnath Tayal, Advocate appearing on behalf of Mr. D.S. Sobti, Advocate for the petitioners states that needful has been done in terms of the assurance held out on behalf of respondent No.2 in terms of order, Annexure P/3 dated 04.12.2018 and that in the circumstances, the petitioners are not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel appearing for the petitioners, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
