The present writ petition has been filed seeking directions to the respondent-department to grant the pay scale of Rs. 4600/- to the petitioner for the post of Superintendent as per the promotion letter and as per the pay scale of the candidate from different department.

After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that with regard to his grievance, the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 13.08.2024 (Annexure P-5) but the respondents have not taken any action thereupon till date. He contends that the petitioner would be satisfied at this stage, in case respondent No.2- Joint Registrar, Haryana State Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, Narnaul, is directed to consider and decide the representation dated

13.08.2024 (Annexure P-5) submitted by the petitioner, by passing a speaking order in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Samrath Sagar, Addl. A.G. Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and prays for some time to complete instructions and file response, if necessary. He, however, does not have any objection to the above request.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation dated dated 13.08.2024 (Annexure P-5) by passing a reasoned and speaking order within a period of four months of the receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to mention that if upon considering the said representation, in case any monetary benefit is found due and payable to the petitioner, the same shall be disbursed in his favour within a further period of two months.
