1. Learned counsel for the parties agreed to that in the present petition has been filed against award dated 05.12.1997 by Labour Court (Annexure P-3), wherein the claim for regularization of the services of the employees working with the petitioner-department was accepted and that the same claim was filed by the Union. Learned counsel for the parties further agree that the petitioner has also raised an independent claim of regularization of his services by filing CWP No.5051 of 2001 which is pending consideration before this Court.

2. Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has already raised the grievance with regard to regularization of his services independently, the present petition is disposed of with the observation that the said claim of the

petitioner will be considered independent of the direction given in the award under the present petition.

3. The issue of regularization will be decided while deciding CWP No.5051 of 2001 independently of the award given in the present petition and the present petition is disposed of with the observation that as the claim of regularization is being considered in another petition hence, the claim of the petitioner for regularization will not be considered under the award in this petition but will be adjudicated independently in the writ petition being CWP No.5051 of 2001.

4. The present is disposed of in the above terms.

5. Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of accordingly.
