1. On 26.05.2025, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Petitioner Sandeep Singh @ Lala @ Lali, aged 30 years, has prayed for grant of interim regular bail for a period of six weeks from the date of release in case FIR No. 22 dated 20.11.2024, under Sections 21(c)/29 NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station SSOC Fazilka, District Intelligence Wing (CID), Punjab, for the reason that his wife is having six months pregnancy and no one else is there to look after her at this juncture of time.

Counsel for the petitioner further contends that his wife namely Ramandeep Kaur had performed marriage against wishes of her parents and therefore, they being not happy with the relations are not expected to be much careful for well being of the wife of the petitioner. In support of the factum of pregnancy, photocopies of the medical record dated 16.01.2025 to 07.03.2025 (P3) has also been appended with the petition. Also points out that earlier also petitioner had approached this Court, but without approaching the Court of Sessions at first instance, therefore, petition was allowed to be withdrawn with liberty to file an appropriate application before the Court concerned.

On filing of application, same has now been dismissed vide impugned order dated 21.05.2025 without assigning any substantial reason. Infact doubt has been raised unnecessarily by the lower Court because the details and particulars mentioned in the report were not sufficient to satisfy the Court.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, learned State counsel, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned State counsel is directed to file status report after verifying the contention raised before this Court and mentioned in the petition.

List on 09.06.2025.”

2. Learned State counsel has filed status report dated 07.06.2025 in the Court today and the same is taken on record.

3. As per paragraph No.8 of the status report, tentative date of delivery of child by pregnant wife of the petitioner namely Ramandeep Kaur is 24.06.2025.

Copy of the medical certificate issued by the concerned doctor of Civil Hospital, Fazilka, has also been appended with the status report.

4. Taking note of the averments mentioned in the petition and submissions addressed by counsel for the petitioner recorded in the order dated 26.05.2025, along with the factual position mentioned in the status report, this Court deems it appropriate to allow the prayer of interim regular bail to the petitioner in the present case. Hence, present petition is allowed, and petitioner is directed to be released on interim regular bail for a period of 6 weeks w.e.f. 24.06.2025, i.e. tomorrow to 06.08.2025, subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/ Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Illaqa Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate concerned, if not required in any other case.

However, it is clarified that petitioner would surrender back to the concerned jail authorities **on 06.08.2025 by 5.00 P.M.**

5. Though, present petition stands disposed of, let the present petition be listed on 11.08.2025, in order to confirm the factum of the petitioner having surrendered back to the jail authorities.
