The applicant/petitioner has moved the present application with a prayer to direct the Superintendent, Central Jail, Faridkot for taking the petitioner to AIIMS Bathinda for providing proper medical treatment. Learned counsel for the applicant/petitioner contends that the applicant/petitioner was brutally beaten up by the police at the place of occurrence and his left foot and leg were fractured due to assault by the police. Later on, the plates were

installed in the leg. However, after confining the applicant/petitioner in Central Jail, Faridkot, he developed some infection and he is also suffering from diabetes. Learned counsel further contends that the applicant/petitioner requires treatment from some super specialty hospital, due to medical problems faced by him.

2. On the other hand, learned State counsel has opposed the submissions made by the learned counsel for the applicant/petitioner on the ground that the applicant/petitioner is having minor health issues and does not require treatment from some multiple super specialty hospital.

3. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

4. In the present case, it is apparent from the record that the applicant/petitioner has suffered infection in the left foot and is a diabetic. Thus, the applicant/petitioner requires immediate medical attention and care. Thus, the Superintendent, Central Jail, Faridkot, is directed to provide best possible treatment to the applicant/petitioner, in accordance with the provisions of jail manual and the settled law. In case, it is found that the applicant/petitioner is suffering from infection/any other medical issue, he shall also be taken to AIIMS, Bathinda for treatment. It is also ordered that in AIIMS, Bathinda, the wife of the applicant/petitioner shall be allowed to stay with him for a period of 06 hours everyday.
