1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C with a prayer to quash the FIR No.31 dated 28.04.2017, under Sections 307,327,324,323,506,148,149 of IPC, registered at Police Station Dera Baba Nanak, District Gurdaspur (Annexure P-1) and order dated 21.05.2024 (Annexure P-4).

2. After arguing at length, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to raise all the pleas available to him before the Trial Court, at an appropriate stage,

3. Dismissed as withdrawn, with liberty aforesaid.

4. However, he prays that the petitioner is a permanent resident of Australia and his all co-accused have been acquitted in the present case and some appropriate directions may be issued to expedite the trial, in the present case.

5. The prayer is allowed and the Trial Court is directed to conclude the trial expeditiously, in accordance with law.
