1. Challenge in this petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, is to the order dated 01.12.2022 (Annexure P-3) passed by Sikh Gurdwara Judicial Commission, Amritsar, whereby, on an application moved by respondent Nos.2 and 3, under Order 39 Rule 1 and 2 CPC along with petition under Section 142 of Sikh Gurdwara Act, 1925, *ex parte ad interim* order was passed and a receiver was appointed.

2. The aforesaid petition and application had been filed by two persons, namely Jagvir Singh and Sardar Harjit Singh. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that during the pendency of the said proceedings, Harjit Singh (respondent No.3), who is the second petitioner before the Sikh Gurdwara Judicial Commission, Amritsar, withdrew his petition, vide order dated 28.07.2023. It is further submitted that thereafter, Jagvir Singh (respondent No.2), who is the first petitioner before the Commission (*supra*), also sought to withdraw the petition. Upon notice of the said application,



reply has also been filed thereto, but the same is not being taken up for consideration and final disposal. It is further submitted that through an application under Order 1 Rule 10 CPC, one Pritam Singh has sought his impleadment as a co-petitioner in the aforesaid petition.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner would be satisfied, at this stage, in case a direction is issued to the Sikh Gurdwara Judicial Commission, Amritsar, to conclude the entire proceedings in a time bound manner.

4. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the record.

5. Keeping in view the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner and without going into merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Sikh Gurdwara Judicial Commission, Amritsar, to dispose of the aforesaid petition under Section 142 of Sikh Gurdwara Act, 1925, along with the applications pending therein, within a period of six months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
