Prayer in this petition is for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondent(s) for not complying the order dated 01.5.2025 (Annexure P-1) passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CRM-M-23018-2025 titled as “Jaspreet Singh vs. State of Punjab and others” vide which the petition was disposed of with the following observation and direction :-

“xxx xxx xxx

*5. After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and perusing the record, it is apparent that the Superintendent of Police, Investigation had given his finding in the enquiry but as submitted before this Court, no action has been taken by the Investigating Agencies.*



6. *In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with direction to the Investigating Agencies to complete the investigation within a period of one month, keeping in view the enquiry report.”*

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Inspector Gurpreet Singh, SHO, Police Station Sadar, Nabha, has informed that in pursuance of directions issued vide order dated 01.5.2025 (Annexure P-1) the challan has been prepared on 27.5.2025 and has been presented before the concerned Court on 13.8.2025; thus, no cause survives in the present petition.

In view of the above undisputed facts, the present contempt petition is hereby **dismissed**.

Rule stands discharged.

Pending application(s), if any, shall stands disposed of.
