ALKA SARIN, J. (ORAL)

1. The present revision petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India challenging the order dated 12.04.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed by the learned Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Gurugram whereby the defence of the petitioner was struck off for not filing the written statement.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner would contend that given one opportunity, the petitioner would file her written statement on the next date of hearing fixed before the Trial Court i.e. 02.05.2025 and that the petitioner is also willing to compensate the respondent by way of costs.

3. Learned counsel for the respondent states that the respondent would have no objection if the petitioner is granted one opportunity to file her written statement.

4. In view of the above, one opportunity is granted to the petitioner to file her written statement on or before the date fixed before the Trial Court i.e. 02.05.2025 subject to payment of ₹10,000 (rupees ten thousand) as costs to be paid to the respondent. The payment of costs shall be a condition precedent for filing of the written statement. It is made clear that in case the written statement is not filed on or before the next date of hearing i.e. 02.05.2025, the present revision petition shall be deemed to having been dismissed.

5. Petition stands disposed off in the above terms. Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed off.
