1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 2(b) read with Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, alleging violation of order dated 15.03.2024, Annexure P-1, passed by the Writ Court in CWP-6170-2024.
2. Advance copy of the petition has been served upon the respondent.
3. State counsel has produced a xerox copy of order dated 02.05,2024, passed by the respondent, to submit that the legal notice dated 05.02.2024, Annexure P-5, served by the petitioner has been decided. Upon instructions, he states that a copy of the order was supplied to the petitioner, which bears his signatures, besides sending it to him through ordinary post. Xerox copy of the order as well as the envelope is taken on record.



4. Counsel for the petitioner has disputed signatures of the petitioner and has taken a stand that the order was never served upon the petitioner. He asserts that a copy of the order has been supplied to him, today.

5. Be that as it may, as order, Annexure P-1, has been complied with, counsel for the petitioner seeks and is granted permission to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to take recourse to the remedy available to the petitioner in accordance with law.
