SUDHIR SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Present Writ Petition herein, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a Writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing the respondents No. 2 to 9 to take immediate steps to install (1) Biogas Power/Bio CNG Plant and provide all basic amenities i.e. proper drainage/sewerage, streets/roads/passage, street light, veterinary care, cattle shelter facilities (shed), space for (1) Milk Collection, (2) Milk Chilling Center, (3) Fodder Store, (4) dumping dung, (5) Bathing Pool (Animals), (6) pucca water tank and adequate water supply and remove encroachment at Tajpur, Dairy Complex Ludhiana with all other consequential benefits appurtenant thereto.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, in case, his representations dated 22.10.2019

(Annexure P-3) and 25.03.2025 (Annexure P-10) are considered and decided by respondent No.2.

3. On the other hand, on advance service of copy of petition, Ms. Arundhati Kulshreshta, AAG, Punjab appears on behalf of respondent-State. She oppose the issuance of notice of motion and submit that the grievance of the petitioner will be looked into by respondent No.2 and it shall take decision either way, on the representation dated 22.10.2019 (Annexure P-3) and 25.03.2025 (Annexure P-10) of the petitioner.

4. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek reply by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

5. Without commenting on merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider the representation dated 22.10.2019 (Annexure P-3) and 25.03.2025 (Annexure P-10) of the petitioner and pass an appropriate reasoned order, in accordance with law, at the earliest, preferably within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of copy/ production of this order.
