1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 04.03.2022, in CWP-4264-2022.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1,04.03.2022, reveals that CWP-4264-2022, was disposed of by directing the respondents to consider legal notice dated 01.12.2021 as a representation and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and if found entitled and there was no legal impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay as per law.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that speaking order dated 14.07.2022 Annexure R-1 has been passed by respondent No.2-Director Rural Development and Panchayats Department, Punjab and certain financial benefits have been found admissible and have been

released to the petitioner. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to the petitioner to challenge order Annexure R/1 dated 14.07.2022, to the extent the same denies the benefits claimed.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge the calculations releasing the benefits to the petitioner vide order Annexure R-1 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.
