1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that it was due to some typographical mistake in the memo of parties that the age of the petitioner has been mentioned as 81 years though he is 62 years old.
2. Let the requisite correction be made in the memo of parties.
3. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.395 dated 02.12.2023, registered under Sections 420, 419, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of IPC and Section 82 of the Registration Act, 1977 (1920 AD) (actually Registration Act 1908), at Police Station Tripuri, District Patiala.
4. Vide order dated 15.05.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner was granted interim bail and was directed to join investigation.



5. Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, has submitted that that the petitioner has joined investigation on 02.06.2025 and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

6. Keeping in view the above mentioned facts and circumstances, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 15.05.2025, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 482(2) of Bharatiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023 (analogous to Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure).
