1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking interim bail in case bearing FIR No. 240 dated 21.04.2024, registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 302, 506 and 120-B of IPC at Police Station Krishna Gate, Thanesar on medical grounds.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has been booked in the aforesaid FIR and is facing trial. He was granted concession of interim bail for a period of one month by the learned trial Court on the grounds that he was suffering from Hernia and was operated upon, vide order dated 21.01.2025. Since the petitioner was still not maintaining good health, he moved an application for extension of interim bail and was granted extension thereof by 15 days with a direction to surrender on 05.03.2025 i.e. today itself. Thereafter, he has again moved an application for

extension of interim bail but the same has been dismissed by the learned trial Court, vide order dated 04.03.2025. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that since the petitioner is still undergoing post surgery treatment, he may be granted interim bail for a limited period.

3. Learned State counsel, who has advance notice of the petition, has not disputed the factual position but has opposed the prayer of the petitioner.

4. After hearing learned counsel for the parties and going through the material placed on record, I am of the considered opinion that since the petitioner is still undergoing post surgery treatment and is not maintaining good health, the interim bail granted to him may be extended for a limited period. In view thereof, the present petition is disposed of. The interim bail, granted to the petitioner, is extended by one week. He is directed to surrender before the jail authorities on 12.03.2025 by 5:00 PM without fail.

5. Let a copy of this order be given *dasti* to learned counsel for the petitioner under the signature of the Reader of this Court.
