3. In the present writ petition, the petitioner is praying for issuance of directions to the respondents to release pending 50% pension alongwith all the arrears with interest of the deceased Sh. Pargat Singh.

4. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, on instructions from the petitioner, submits that the present writ petition be treated as a representation and at this stage, he will be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.2 to decide his representation, in a time bound manner.

5. Notice of motion.

6. Mr. Vikas Arora, DAG, Punjab appearing for respondent No.1 and Mr. Gaurav Singh Bhatti, Advocate appearing for respondents No.2 and 3 do not oppose the prayer, as made by the learned counsel for the petitioner. He has duly submitted the power of attorney, which is taken on record.

7. Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes to supply the copy of present writ petition to the learned counsel for the respondents during the course of the day.

8. In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present writ petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to treat the present writ petition as a representation on behalf of the petitioner and decide the same within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case the petitioner is held entitled for the benefit, as claimed by him in the present writ petition, the same be also released to the petitioner in accordance with law within a period of 08 weeks thereafter.
