1. This petition has been filed under Section 528 of the BNSS, 2023 for issuance of direction for transfer of cross-case registered vide G.D. No.36 dated 07.03.2025 under Sections 299, 115(2), 126(2), 324(4) in FIR No.38 dated 10.02.2025 registered under Sections 74, 115(2), 126(2), 351(2) of the BNS, 2023 at Police Station Division No.7, Ludhiana, to any other police station in District Ludhiana. Further prayer has been made for issuance of direction to respondent No.3 to file a status report before this Court with regard to the investigation conducted by the police till date.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has also moved a representation (Annexure P-8) before the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, for taking legal action against respondents No.5 to 7, however, no action has been taken thereon till

date. He submits that at this stage, petitioner would be satisfied, if the said representation is considered and decided by passing a speaking order in a time-bound frame.

3. Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only at this stage.

4. Mr. Adhiraj Singh, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents No.1 to 4-State.

5. Without commenting upon the merits of the claim of the petitioner and even the assertions set out in the petition, the same is disposed of only with a direction to respondent No.2 – Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, that if any such representation, as indicated above, is indeed pending consideration, that shall be dealt with expeditiously in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and convey the same to the petitioner.

6. The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
