1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondents for violating the order dated 22.05.2024 passed by the Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Karnala.
2. Perusal of the case file shows that the order dated 22.05.2024 which has been allegedly violated, was passed by the Civil Court. The said Court is having sufficient power and wide competence to get its own order executed. Therefore, this Court does not find it appropriate to continue with the present petition any more.
3. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
4. However, the petitioners would be at liberty to raise their grievance before the concerned Court, but in accordance with law.
