1. The present writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India with a prayer for issuance of an appropriate writ or order in the nature of *certiorari* for quashing the transfer order dated 15.09.2025 (Annexure P-5) whereby the petitioner has been transferred from Ambala to Ferozepur Zhirka, District Nuh just after three months of her present place of posting, in absolute disregard to transfer policy dated 15.06.2023 (Annexure P-6).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that she was appointed as Mandi Supervisor on 19.02.2024 and was granted posting at Raipur-Rani. Thereafter, on 28.02.2025, she was again transferred from Raipur Rani to Ambala City. Surprisingly, just after a period of three months, she was again ordered to be transferred from Ambala to Ferozepur

Zirka, District Nuh vide impugned order dated 15.09.2025. Lastly, she prays for quashing the impugned order dated 15.09.2025 (Annexure P-5), which is against the transfer policy.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Piyush Khanna, Additional Advocate General waives service of notice on behalf of respondent No.1, whereas, Mr. Prince Singh, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.2.

5. At this stage, learned counsel for respondent No.2-Board on instructions from Mr. Manoj, Mandi Supervisor submits that the grievance raised by the petitioner in the present petition would be redressed by posting her at Market Committee Naneola, District Ambala or within District Ambala and further submits that the transfer order dated 15.09.2025 (Annexure P-5) would be withdrawn and fresh orders would be issued within three days.

6. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for respondent No.2, nothing survives in the present petition. Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of and petitioner is granted a week's time to join her next place of posting.

7. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stands disposed of.
