The application is allowed as prayed for.

Main Case

1. The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of an appropriate order or direction to official respondents to take appropriate legal action against the private respondents/accused persons who given severe beatings and caused injuries to the petitioner and take action on their representation dated 16.01.2025 (Annexure P-3).

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioner has recently filed a representation on 16.01.2025 before the Senior Superintendent of Police, District Pathankot (Annexure P-3) raising their grievances as mentioned in the present petition



but the same has not yet been considered and no action has been taken thereon. He further submitted that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Pathankot to decide the aforesaid representation filed by the petitioners and take necessary action thereon.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Himani Arora, AAG, Punjab who is present in Court, has accepted the notice on behalf of the respondents-State and submits that the needful will be done in due course. Let a complete set of the paperbook be supplied to her during the course of the day.

5. In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No. 2 to decide the aforesaid representation dated 16.01.2025 (Annexure P-3) of the petitioner within a period of 15 days from today, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.
