1. Challenge in the instant writ petition is to the office orders bearing No. CUH/2024/Estt.Sec./T/563 dated 25.07.2024; No. CUH/Estt.Sec./T/2024/568 dated 29.07.2024; No. CUH/Estt.Sec./T/2024/569 dated 29.07.2024; No. CUH/Estt.Sec./T/2024/570 dated 29.07.2024; communication No.CUH/VCS/2024/1339 dated 17.12.2024 and the show cause notice dated 25.02.2025 alongwith all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

2. Vakalatnama(s) on behalf of respondents No. 4 and 5 respectively have been filed today in the Court and the same are taken on record.

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that the respondents have passed an order of termination dated 07.05.2025



whereby the services of the petitioner have been discontinued during the pendency of the instant writ petition. She fairly submits that the aforesaid order need to be challenged. She thus prays for withdrawal of the instant writ petition with liberty to file a fresh writ petition on the same cause of action and also impugning the subsequent developments.

4. Disposed of as withdrawn with the liberty as aforesaid.
