MAHESH GROVER, J.

The order dated 11.01.2012, non-compliance of which has been alleged by the petitioner, required the respondents to consider the case of the petitioner for promotion as contained in his representation and pass a speaking order thereon within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

Reply reveals that the needful has been done and the petitioner has been granted promotion.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that all consequential benefits have not been given to him.

This fact is, however, controverted by counsel for the respondent who has stated that the needful has been done.

Having regard to the aforesaid, the contempt petition is disposed of by discharging the rule against the respondents. However, it is directed that in case all the consequential benefits have not being given to the petitioner, the same shall be released to him positively within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
