SHEEL NAGU, CHIEF JUSTICE, (ORAL)

1. The petitioner was a successful allottee of Liquor Vend Code LU-38 in Sector 31, Chandigarh for the retail sale of country-made as well as foreign liquor for the year 2025-2026, ending on 13th of March, 2025. There is no dispute by the respondent regarding the allotment made to the petitioner.
2. An apprehension has been expressed by learned counsel for the petitioner that in case CWP-8637-2025, CWP-8642-2025 and CWP-8672-2025, are allowed, the auction process in which the petitioner was one of the successful bidders may adversely affect the petitioner's claim under the contract.
