1. Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 for issuance of directions to official respondents to not to harass the petitioner by repeatedly calling him to police station and further to give him seven days' notice in case, any FIR is registered against him.

2. Learned State counsel, on instructions from SHO, Police Station Juner, Mansa, at the very outset, submits that nothing survives in the present petition as the petitioner has approached this Court apprehending that he will be involved in an FIR as there is a complaint against the son of the petitioner. He further submits that the presence of the petitioner is not required for examining the veracity of the complaint filed against his son.

3. In view of the specific stand taken by learned State counsel, no further directions are required and the present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
