



that similarly placed co-accused, namely, Gobind Singh alias Kudan alias Kundan has been granted the concession of anticipatory bail by this Court, vide order dated 18.10.2024 passed in CRM-M-45519-2024 (Annexure P-3).

3. On the other hand, learned State counsel has vehemently opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner on the ground that the petitioner had fired indiscriminately on the complainant and does not deserve the concession of bail by this Court.

4. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

5. In the present case, the complainant did not suffer any fire arm injury and had suffered certain superficial injuries. The petitioner is stated to be in custody for the last about 08 months and the challan has been presented against him. Even the prosecution has not been able to examine even a single witness so far and the conclusion of the trial may take quite a long time.

6. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate, concerned.
