The order dated 21.09.2011, non-compliance of which has been alleged by the petitioner required the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner in terms of the rehabilitation and re-settlement scheme intended for persons whose land had been acquired.

Pursuant thereto respondents have considered the claim of the petitioner and passed a speaking order rejecting the claim of the petitioner.

In view of the stand taken by the respondents, it is evident that the orders of this Court had been complied with, the rule against the respondents is discharged and instant petition is disposed of with liberty to impugn the action of the respondents in the eventuality of his having any surviving grievance.
