JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to grant him promotion to the rank of Assistant Sub Inspector with retrospective effect.

2. The petitioner claims that Sub Inspector Gurdawaya Ram and Onkar Singh were junior to him or had passed Lower School Course on the same date, however, they were promoted to the rank of Assistant Sub Inspector prior to him. Their promotion was made retrospective and their actual date of promotion was at par with him. He also deserves retrospective promotion.



3. Mr. Raman Sharma, Addl. A.G., Haryana assures the Court that competent authority would consider claim of the petitioner in the light of order dated 31.08.1999 passed in the case of ASI Onkar Singh No. 179/A.

4. In the wake of statement of learned State counsel, the instant petition stands disposed of. Let the needful be done within six months from today.
