**SURYA PARTAP SINGH, J. (Oral):**

1. This is a petition for anticipatory bail filed under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita 2023, in a case arising out of FIR No.72 dated 09.03.2025 under Sections 115(2), 351(2), 3(5), 333, 118(1), 127(2) of BNS (Section 118(2) BNS added later on), Police Station City Mandi Dabwali, District Sirsa.

2. Vide order dated 21.08.2025, the petitioner was admitted to interim anticipatory bail, subject to the condition of furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer.

3. On behalf of respondent-State, learned State Counsel has filed reply by way of affidavit of Inspector/Station House Officer, Police Station, City Mandi Dabwali, District Sirsa. The same be taken on record.

4. It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that in compliance with above mentioned order, dated 21.08.2025, the petitioner has



already joined investigation.

5. On the instructions of ASI Satnam Singh, Police Station City Mandi Dabwali, District Sirsa, who is present in the Court, the learned State Counsel has stated that in compliance with the order dated 21.08.2025, the petitioner has joined investigation, and that the custody of the petitioner is not required for the investigation of present case.

6. In view of the above mentioned submission of learned State counsel, the order dated 21.08.2025, whereby interim anticipatory bail was accorded to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute.

Present petition stands allowed, accordingly.
