1. Present petition under Section 483 of BNSS has been filed by the petitioner for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.201 dated 17.11.2022, registered under Section 18 of NDPS Act, at Police Station GRP Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.
2. The co-ordinate Bench of this Court, vide order dated 20.02.2025 passed in CRM-M-30080-2024, dismissed the petition on merits by applying the embargo under Section 37 of the NDPS Act.
3. Since petitioner is unable to address much of the submissions on merits, instant petition is not maintainable.
