1. The petitioner through instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to fix their pay at par with their juniors.
2. The petitioners claim that their juniors are getting more salary/pension because of pay anomaly. It is settled law that nobody can be paid lesser salary than his juniors. The petitioners have filed representation but to no avail.
3. Ms. Rajni Gupta, Addl. A.G., Haryana submits that petitioner Nos. 2 and 3 retired a couple of years back and they did not raise objection while in service. Nevertheless, the representation of petitioners would be considered including question of limitation within 3 months from today.

4. In the wake of statement of both sides, the petition stands disposed of. It is hereby made clear that in case representation of the petitioners is accepted, they would be entitled to revised pay/pension from the date of filing petition before this Court.
