1. This petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the order dated 21.05.2025 (Annexure P-2), vide which, the evidence of the revisionist was closed. Revisionist wants to place on record the copies of dead certificate of Kuldeep Singh dated 18.06.2022 and Mohar Singh dated 03.01.2024. The documents which revisionist wants to tender into evidence are *per se* admissible and coming from the official record and it would not delay the disposal of the proceedings, so revision petition is allowed and impugned order is set aside and revisionist is granted only one opportunity to place on record the certified copies of the death certificates subject to payment of cost of Rs.5,000/-.

2. Accordingly, the revision petition is dismissed. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, are also disposed of accordingly
