1. In the present case, the respondent had filed the suit for declaration in the year 1983 to the effect that the letter dated 02.03.1983 received by the plaintiff on 11.03.1983 was illegal, null and void. The said suit filed by the plaintiff had been dismissed and appeal filed against the same was allowed. A perusal of the paperbook would show that no stay is operating in favour of the State.

2. None has appeared on behalf of the respondent.

3. Learned State counsel has submitted that in view of the same, present appeal may be disposed of at this stage but liberty may be granted to the appellants to revive the appeal, in case, any cause of action survives or arises in future.

4. In view of the above, present appeal is disposed of at this stage with the aforesaid liberty.
