SANJAY VASHISTH, J.

1. On 29.05.2025, following order was passed:-

“Prayer in this petition, filed under Section 482 of the BNSS, 2023 (earlier Section 438 Cr.P.C.), is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, who has been booked in a criminal case arising out of First Information Report, as detailed hereunder:-

There are serious allegations against the petitioner-Tarun Sharma of giving kick and punches to the injured-Dinesh Kumar, it is also alleged that petitioner-Tarun Sharma gave a spade blow on neck and vest.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, inter alia, contends that during the course of investigation, petitioner was found innocent as he was found present at his workplace at the time of incident. FIR is also registered after a period of 6 days, naming the petitioner and another accused therein on the basis of assumptions. Counsel also contends that petitioner has now been summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C. and



he is ready to join the process of law by appearing before the Trial Court.

Thus, prays for grant of concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case.

4. *Notice of motion.*

5. *On advance notice, learned State counsel puts in appearance on behalf of the respondent – State, and seeks some time to respond to the submissions addressed by learned counsel opposite, after seeking instructions. And, in case of necessity, to file status report.*

6. *Adjourned to 23.07.2025.*

State would also explain the evidence recorded by it thereby concluding the presence of the petitioner at the workplace.

7. *In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation as and when required to do so by the Investigating Agency. In the event of his arrest, the petitioner shall be released on ad-interim bail, subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer.*

The petitioner shall also be abide by all the conditions laid down under Section 482(2) of BNSS, 2023 (earlier Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.). 8. Besides, it is directed that petitioner would hand over his passport to the Investigating Agency or to Court concerned, if he possesses.

Otherwise, would submit an affidavit, disclosing the fact that he does not possess any passport. It is also directed that before leaving country any time during trial, petitioner would seek prior permission of the Court.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in compliance of the order dated 29.05.2025, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation, and has fully co-operated.

4. Learned State counsel has filed status report dated 22.07.2025 in the Court today and the same is taken on record.

Learned State counsel on instructions from PSI Vinod Kumar, confirms the said averment and submits that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner would not be required now for the purpose of investigation.

5. Heard learned counsel for the parties.

6. Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and since custodial interrogation is no more required, present petition is allowed and ad-interim order dated 29.05.2025, passed by this Court is hereby made absolute.

However, petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when required to do so and abide by all the terms and conditions laid down under Section 482(2) of BNSS, 2023.

7. Accordingly, petition stands disposed of.
