1. Learned counsel submits that the petitioners who were working as Sewing Teacher and Music Teacher, are seeking pay scale admissible to cadre Classical and Vernacular Teachers, being a part and parcel thereof and the previous writ petitions filed by them were disposed of on 23.09.2024 (Annexure P19) on the statement of learned State counsel that in case any representation is submitted, the same would be decided in accordance with law and in case it is found feasible the relief shall be granted. Pursuant whereof, a detailed legal notice dated 11.11.2024 (Annexure P20) was served, however, the same has yet not evoked any response. He thus, on instructions, prays that a direction may be given to the respondents to decide the same in a time bound manner, to which learned State counsel has no objection to the limited prayer made.

2. In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 11.11.2024, within a period of 6 months, which this Court has no reason to believe the authorities would not address in a just, fair and reasonable manner. Upon doing so, after notice and hearing offered to them and if found entitled, grant the benefit forthwith. Needless to say, if the orders are adverse to their interest, the same shall contain reasons and the petitioners shall be free to seek legal redress thereupon.
