The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023 in a cross-case bearing GD No.19 dated 24.12.2021 under Sections 323, 324, 326, 148, 149 IPC (Section 307 IPC added later on) in FIR No.338 dated 17.12.2021 under Sections 323, 325, 326, 308, 148, 149 IPC and Section 3 of the SC/ST Act, 1989 registered at Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 27.08.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The short reply dated 28.09.2025 filed on behalf of the respondent-State is taken on record.

The learned State counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 27.08.2025 and is not required for custodial interrogation.
