RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 2-B read with Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for disobedience of order dated 08.08.2022 passed by this court in CWP-5915-2022.

2. In compliance of order dated 08.08.2022, the counsel for the respondents-State has already placed on record affidavit on behalf of respondent No.3, which is taken on record.

3. The counsel for the respondents-State, after going through the aforesaid affidavit, has submitted that the order, qua which contempt was asserted, has since been complied with by passing promotion order.



No further action is required in the matter. Accordingly, the present petition has been rendered as infructuous.

4. Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unaddressed, the petitioner will be at liberty to avail any other remedy, but in accordance with law.
