ANIL KSHETARPAL, J. (Oral)

1. This is the land owners' appeal seeking enhancement in the amount of compensation awarded by the Land Acquisition Collector, which has been upheld by the Reference Court. The appellants have produced copies of the various sale deeds which pertained to different villages than the village in which acquired land is located, hence, correctly discarded by the Reference Court. The appellant has also relied upon the Reference Court award Ex.PD, which relates to acquisition of land abutting National Highway, whereas, the acquired land in this acquisition is located 6 kms from the National Highway, hence, correctly rejected by the Reference Court is upheld. The land represented in award Ex. PD is not comparable with the acquired land.
2. Learned counsel representing the appellants did not press any other issue, hence, the judgment of the Reference Court is upheld.
3. The appeal is disposed of.
4. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
