HARKESH MANUJA J. (Oral)

1. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the payment stands released in favour of the petitioner vide speaking order dated 20.02.2025.

date of its receipt by passing a speaking order thereupon, which shall be conveyed to the petitioner within a period of two weeks thereafter and in case of any delay on the part of respondent(s), the officer(s) concerned would be liable to pay costs of Rs. 50,000/- to the petitioner from his / her own pocket.
