For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed and the main case is taken on board today itself.

**CRWP-10977-2024**

1.             Counsel appearing on behalf of petitioner No.1 submits that earlier petitioner No.1, who is female aged about 20 years was living with petitioner No.2 of her own free will and volition but now the said relationship is over and petitioner No.1 has returned to her parental home and is residing with her parents i.e. respondents No.4 and 5, peacefully



without having any apprehension of threat to her life and liberty from the side of said private respondents. Counsel for petitioner No.1 further stated that in the given circumstances, petitioner No.1 be permitted to withdraw the present petition.

2. Counsel appearing on behalf of respondents No.4 to 6 made statement that petitioner No.1 is daughter of respondents No.4 and 5 and now she is residing with her parents, peacefully and the said respondents are having no objection if petitioner No.1 is permitted to withdraw the present petition at this stage.

3. Even, the State counsel has no objection if the prayer made by counsel for petitioner No.1 is accepted.

4. In light of the above, one thing is clear that now petitioner No.1 is living separately from petitioner No.2 and rather she has come back to her parents home and is residing with her parents peacefully and thus there is no question of threat to life and liberty of petitioner No.1.

5. For the foregoing reasons, the present petition is hereby dismissed as withdrawn at this stage.

6. Pending application having CRM-W-101-2025 also stands disposed of.
